



CRASH Checklist



- Get out of the street if possible, but don't move if you are in pain.
- Call 9-1-1 or have someone else do it.
- If your crash involves a car, fill in the driver's info on the **reverse of this card**. Ask the driver to NOT move the car. If the driver leaves, note the license plate, make, & model of the car.
- Get witnesses' contact info. Ask them to stay until police arrive.
- If there are serious injuries involved, request a crash report from the police. If no injuries, fill out a "blue form" from the police ASAP, including witness, insurance, and contact info for everyone involved in the crash.
- Take photos of the crash location, road condition, signs/signals, & condition of your bicycle & the car.
- Go to the hospital to get checked even if you think you're OK.
